Facts

The word astronaut comes from the Greek words Astron nautes, which means star sailor.

The first astronaut in space was Yuri Gagarin in 1961. The first astronaut to walk on the moon was Neil Armstrong in 1969.

Spacesuits provide astronauts with air, protect them from the extreme temperatures of space and from the radiation of the Sun.

People have trained to become astronauts from lots of different countries. Tim Peake was the first British astronaut to do a space walk.

An astronaut's spacesuit cost \$12 million dollars each.

Charles Duke who flew on Apollo 16 left a picture of his family on the moon with a message on the back that said "This is the family of astronaut Charlie Duke from planet Earth who landed on the moon on April 20, 1972."

When astronauts go to sleep in space they have to buckle up so they don't float around the space ship and bump into anything.
